#### From the Pastor's Desk:

In the later writings of the Old Testament, wisdom is often personified, as we hear her described in the first reading from Proverbs this weekend. She is the attendant at God's throne. a foreshadowing of the Holy Spirit that Christians believe is the third person of the Holy Trinity.

The wisdom of God is far beyond any human understanding, and the gifts of the Spirit greater than any human imagining.

We may not comprehend fully all that the Eucharist is for us. We may not even understand deeply the mystery of the real presence of Christ in the sacrament of his body and blood. But in our Communion with him we are joined intimately with Christ, and the gift of the Holy Spirit is strengthened in us. When we receive the body and blood of Christ at Mass he remains in us and we remain in him, a gift beyond our imagining.

#### From Deacon Don's Desk:

Usually after the Sunday homily I have 'leftovers" - instead I ask you to read the "Scripture Focus" for this Sunday. Looking for a life-changing bible verse? Try Psalm 77:12 - "I remember the deeds of the

Lord." I selected out of the "Living Faith" booklet the following: Remembering what God has done is to view our life in the context of reality. If we forget what God has done, we neglect reality; inevitably, we go astray. How do we remember? First we remember in the Mass. Not simply remembering a past event, the Mass is the great remembering in which Christ's sacrifice again becomes present to us. We remember that God has created us, that He has sent His Son to us, that His Son has given His life for us. But we each need our own ways to remember. Recite the above Psalm, not once but over a few times and dwell on it.

It's our time to return that "fidelity" to God who has shown His "fidelity" to us. Semper Fi!

Our Prayer: Heavenly Father, make me realize that the Eucharist is the memorial of Christ's action that freed us of our sins. Help us to participate devoutly in every Eucharist and obtain the grace to avoid sin. We ask this in Your Son's name. Amen.

#### **Small Church Community**

Scripture Focus: John's Gospel has no direct account of the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. Rather, it includes this sermon on the Bread of Life that we have been hearing for the past several weeks. The statement of the opening verse, "the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world," is very close to the account in Luke's Gospel of Jesus blessing bread at the Last Supper and saying "This is my body given for you." Accepting the teaching of Jesus, the Liturgy of the Word, important as this is, only prepares us to share his body and blood. Participation in the Eucharist brings present possession of "eternal life" and is thus a pledge of eventual resurrection. Life Focus: How does believing in "eternal Life" affect your daily living? \* What have you done with this "life" received in the Eucharist? \* Describe an experience when you have been the "bread of life" for others.
