From the Pastor's Desk:

We each have our own understanding of who Jesus is. Those perceptions were formed in the home when we were young, through school and religious education classes as we grew older, maybe through some theology classes in

college, by the movies and songs of contemporary culture, and by the preaching and prayer of the church. All of those influences build up our own understanding of who Jesus is. Some of our conceptions of who Jesus is may be very much aligned with the understanding of the church, while others may be very far from the faith we proclaim in the creed.

Wrestling with who Jesus is for us is nothing new. The Gospel itself points out that there were plenty of people in Jesus' own time who thought he was someone other than who he was. Even after Peter confessed Jesus to be the Christ, he didn't quite get what that meant. Take a moment today to consider who Jesus is in your own life.
