

From the Pastor's Desk:

In the Gospels, it is at Jesus' baptism in the Jordan and at his transfiguration that a voice from heaven proclaims, "This is my chosen Son." This manifestation of God's glory through a voice from the cloud sets the stage for what

is to follow. Jesus' teaching, miracles, preaching, death, and resurrection are all heralded by the announcement that he is God's chosen Son.

In this Lenten season, as we prepare for the annual renewal of our baptismal vows at Easter, we recognize that we too are God's chosen sons and daughters. In baptism we became one with Christ. Baptism heralded what we are to be: men and women who live and act like Christ each day. We know that we don't always do this, and so we use these forty days before Easter to return to the Lord so that we may faithfully live the life of Christ.





EUCHARISTIC ADORATION Thursday, March 4, 6-8 pm

From Deacon Don's Desk:

I'm going to "steal" a mini-homily from a Jesuit priest, John Powell, SJ. He tells of his philosophy student, Tommy (an atheist) at Loyola U. of Chicago who came to him and said, "Do you think I will ever find God?" "No" replied Powell, ink Cod will find you." Years later Temmy returned

"but I think God will find you." Years later Tommy returned to John Powell to tell him he had terminal cancer. Tommy said, "I want to find God, or at least to be in the right place at the right time to be found by Him." Powell told him to go and tell the people that he most loved in the world that he loved them. Within a week Tommy reported to Fr. Powell that in doing what he told him, he had a genuine and deep encounter with God, they found each other. Tommy died three months later. Fr. Powell said that in the process of telling others he loved them, he was transfigured by God. St. John's letter says, "If you say you love God, yet you hate your brother or sister, you are a liar." The Transfiguration is not meant for Jesus alone. It is meant for us to experience God's love as His children through Jesus. The problem is we have devalued love like our present day currency. Two things to remember: if we feel distant from God, we only have to guess who has moved away from whom. God cannot stop loving us. And, God loves us as we are, not as we would like to be. As the saying goes, "You don't have to get good to get God, you have to get God to get good." Listen to God again at Mt. Tabor, "You are my child, I love you. Listen to My Son."

Our Prayer: Father, we pray for a true transformation during this Lenten season and for the ability to get properly oriented so as to live the life You intended for us. We make this our Lenten resolution so that Easter will find us spiritually renewed. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.

Scripture Focus: One of the key themes in Luke's Gospel is glory. As Jesus is transfigured, Moses and Elijah appear "in glory." When the apostles awake, they see only Jesus' "glory." Moses and Elijah reveal that Christ's passage would be through suffering to glory. The voice of God identifies Jesus as God's chosen son, and commands the apostles to listen, to listen to what Jesus has just announced - his approaching death and resurrection. In this passage, the glory of God will be revealed.

Life Focus: * Describe a time when you stopped to listen closely to another person. * Relate an event that enabled you to carry on through a difficult time in your life. * What are some "mountaintop" experiences in your life? * Describe a hardship you experienced that made you a better person. * Share an experience in your life that you wanted to last forever, that you wished would never end. * Tell of a time when you were frustrated trying to share an intense experience with others.


