

From the Pastor's desk:

Peter, James and John had their struggles and difficulties in leaving family, friends and security behind in order to follow Jesus. They didn't always understand what was going on, or what Jesus' purpose was but they faithfully

stayed with him.

Now before the road to Jerusalem begins, they got a glimpse of Jesus in all his splendor as Son of God. This man with whom they have laughed and cried is revealed to them in Mystery.

As disciples of Jesus we need our own high points, the chances to recognize the power and glory of God in the midst of our lives today. "Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus." A writer once said, "The readings give us three famous mountain climbers: Moses, who climbed Mount Sinai and received the 10 Commandments. Elijah climbed

Mount Carmel and was given the gift to conquer evil that was in the land: the evil prophets of the pagan god Baal. Jesus climbed the mount of Transfiguration with His trusted disciples and was given as **the gift** for the people: a cloud came casting a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice, "This is My beloved Son. Listen to Him." Mk 9:7-8.

Let us pray for our own religious transfiguration in the Father's love this Lent, and may the Eucharist give us hope through faith that no matter what altar of sacrifice we may feel heaped upon us God never wants us to give up: His love is never destructive. His love always leads to life.

Lent is our journey of faith. We are called to trust in the Lord in our life's challenges and struggles. The one gift from the Lord that is never denied us is the gift of **faith**. OUR PRAYER: Heavenly Father, help me to fast for the right reason. Grant me grace to believe in the Gospel and to read that Gospel continually. Then let me put it into practice.
