What does this feast of **Pentecost** mean to us? It's one of the most important solemnities in the Church. Here is part of how Pope Benedict summarized it: "This Solemnity makes us remember and relive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the

Apostles and other disciples in prayer with the Virgin Mary in the Upper Room. Jesus, risen and ascended into Heaven, sent His Spirit to the Church so that every Christian might participate in His own divine life and become His valid witness to the world. The Holy Spirit, breaking into history, defeats aridity, opens hearts to hope, stimulates and fosters in us an interior maturity in our relationship with God and our neighbor."

Does the Spirit speak? Well, Acts 10:19-20, "Peter was still trying to understand what the vision meant, when the Spirit said, "Listen! Three men are looking for you. So get ready and go down and do not hesitate to go with them for I have sent them." Acts 13:2 While they were serving the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said: "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul to do the work which I have called them." Again in Acts 8:28 the Spirit talks to Phillip. The Holy Spirit intercedes for us. Matthew 28:19-20 Jesus said, "Go then to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. And I will be with you always to the end of the age."


