

## The Most Holy Trinity May 31, 2015

St. Joseph Parish is a community of believers who uphold the teachings of the Gospel and the traditions of the Roman Catholic Church, foster the formation and enrichment of parishioners in spirituality, worship and education, providing a welcoming environment to all.

We live Christian lives by praying together, caring for our diverse community, encouraging and sharing of ourselves in service to others.

#### From the Pastor's desk:

Sometimes it is hard for us to understand what goes on inside another person, what they might be thinking or what they might be feeling. At other times, especially when we love the other person we would like to be almost inside the other person's heart and mind, and feel united with

the other person's neart and mind, and feel united with them as if we were one.

The same thing happens to us in relation to God. It is not easy to speak about God. It is not easy to speak about something even more remote and mysterious than the people that are close to us whom we can see and touch.

"No one has ever seen God." God belongs to another order of beings. At the same time, however, God is everywhere, in everything, and in us. Maybe we don't meet God as we would meet a neighbor or a friend, but there are many ways to meet and to know someone.

We say that God is Father precisely because we experience him as Creator, generating life. When we recall Jesus, who was born in Bethlehem and went about doing good, healing the sick, and announcing the reign of God, we see that he spoke about God as his "Daddy," "Abba." He is the Son of God.

After Jesus' death the disciples felt the presence of the Spirit of God who gave them courage, inspired them, and encouraged them to announce the Good News of the reign of God.

We speak of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Are these three different ways of looking at the same reality? No, there is much more to it than that. There are no real ways of describing God. All we can do is talk about a way of being: God is a mystery of love, a mystery of relationship.

### From Deacon Don's desk:

In our pre-Baptism class Tina always asks the question: "Don, why DO we Baptize?" I stammer while flipping pages in the Bible. Finally I come to the very last paragraph in Matthew's Gospel 28:16

-20, "The eleven disciples went up Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw Him, they worshiped, but they **doubted**. Then Jesus said to them: "All power in heaven and on earth has been give to Me. **Go**, therefore, make disciples of **all** nations, **Baptizing** them in the name of the **Father**, and of the **Son**, and of the **Holy Spirit**, teaching them to observe all I have commanded you. And behold I am with you always to the end of the age." There you have it folks. **Jesus** said do it!!

Jesus understands our weakness that's why He says He will be with us until the end of the age.

In other words; He's got our back.

In Mose's time monotheism (belief in one God) was relatively a foreign concept to Israel as well as other regions. Moses gives the Israelites two conditions: Number one, "Fix in your heart that there is no other God in heaven or on earth. And second be faithful to the Law received on Mt. Sinai, "Keep His statues and commandments."

The Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit describes an experience of one, true God who creates, liberates and makes us holy. We are, in this God, a community of persons, we are now formed by our Baptism.

OUR PRAYER: Lord Jesus Christ, let us be closely united with You in all things. Grant that we may carry our cross willingly because of You and in union with You we are one in You. Amen


