

From the desk of Fr. Francis:

It's fascinating that General Electric, Hewlett Packard, IBM and Microsoft all came about during a severe economic downturn. When we look at history, it shouldn't be a surprise that challenging times have served as catalysts for

innovation, accomplishment and creativity. Unfortunately, when we are going through difficult moments in our life, it's very tempting to just settle where we are and develop a "survival mentality." I remember talking to a lady who went through a bitter divorce and even though it's been over ten years and she had a great job, each time I asked her how she was doing, she always said, "I'm just surviving. I'm barely making it." But I don't think God wants us to simply survive. He wants us to thrive where we are.

Times may be difficult. You may have doubts of how things will work out. But don't forget that in this Sunday's gospel reading, Jesus took five loaves and two fish and multiplied them to feed thousands of people. Not only did He feed them, He fed them in abundance. If He can do that, He can also multiply what you have. He can multiply your talent so you can get more things done. He can multiply your wisdom and help you make more Christ-like decisions. Scripture says in psalm 145: "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs." Just remember that our God is in complete control. So when tough times hit and you're tempted to give into despair, instead have the boldness to say, "I will not just survive. I will thrive. I will trust in God and rise above this challenge knowing that He is holding me in the palm of His hands."

May God bless you and may you never allow anyone to steal your joy!

Did You Know? Helping children problem solve

through communication - Often the easiest response to complicated conversations is a generic one, but these moments can be opportunities to help children grow. For example, if a child comes to you and tells you that a friend is being left out of social activities, you might respond with a question: "Do you think there is anything you can do help him/her feel more included?" Or if your child comes to you for money for social activities, instead of offering a solution, you might prompt them to consider ways that they could earn money or fundraise on their own. In this way, you are not only helping a child find a solution to an immediate situation, but also helping them to grow in wisdom and prudence. 


