### Monsignor Kevin Kostelnik

Monsignor Kevin Kostelnik was born in Lorain, Ohio on June 20, 1955 and is the eldest child of Beverly and Joseph Kostelnik. Monsignor has one sister, Kathy and two brothers, Keith and Ken. Msgr. Kevin attended St. John's Seminary College and St. John's Seminary in Camarillo and was ordained to the Priesthood in 1982. In 1992, he received his Master's Degree in Liturgical Studies from the University of Notre Dame. Monsignor Kostelnik's first assignment was Associate Pastor at Saint John Fisher Church in Palos Verdes, California from 1982 to 1987. For two years he served as Associate Pastor of Saint Andrew Church in Pasadena. In 1989, Cardinal Roger Mahony appointed Monsignor Kostelnik as his Priest Secretary. In 1996, Monsignor Kostelnik was appointed first Pastor of the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels. Msgr. Kevin enjoys working out at the Downtown Athletic Club, cooking Italian Pasta with friends in a Gourmet Group, barbecuing on the grill for the clergy in the Residence, and enjoying a glass, or two, of Chardonnay wine. For the past twelve years the Cathedral family got to know Msgr. Kevin's black Labrador, Joaquin, who went home to pet heaven last winter. One weekend every fall, you'll find Msgr. Kevin in the stands at the Notre Dame Stadium in South Bend, cheering on his favorite team, The Fighting Irish. On July 1, 2016 Monsignor Kostelnik will conclude his term as First Pastor of the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels. ### From Deacon Don's desk:

Fr. Lawrence Caruso, former Administrator and Pastor of St. Anthony Church, Long Beach wrote: "There are many symbols that we identify with the feast of Christmas. Many are of pagan origin or secularized such as the Christmas tree or Santa Claus, a faint shadow of St. Nicholas, a 4th century saint, and of course Rudolph the red-nose reindeer. But there is one symbol of Christmas that is thoroughly Catholic in its origin and in its significance and that is the Creche or Nativity scene. Surprisingly the Christmas Crib had a rather late birth in Christian history. It began with St. Francis of Assisi in the year 1221. St Francis wanted to do something different that Christmas, something that would stir the hearts of the people to appreciate the real meaning of Christmas. He asked that the people gather outside the town of Greccio for Midnight Mass. There he reproduced the original nativity scene. A stable was built, hay and animals were brought in, an altar was built. There was no infant Jesus, because Jesus would be present in the Eucharist. It was in this setting that an infant appeared in a vision on the altar as lifeless. Francis picked up the infant and roused him as from a deep sleep. The vision reflected the truth that the Child Jesus had been forgotten in the hearts of many, but with God's grace He was brought to life again through His servant, Francis."

My prayer: May this Christmas be the occasion of a re-birth of the Child Jesus in our own hearts. May it be a renewal of that life that Jesus gave to us through baptism. May our "Merry Christmas" not be an echo that will fade during the end of this week but a continuing message of life in joy and peace. Amen
