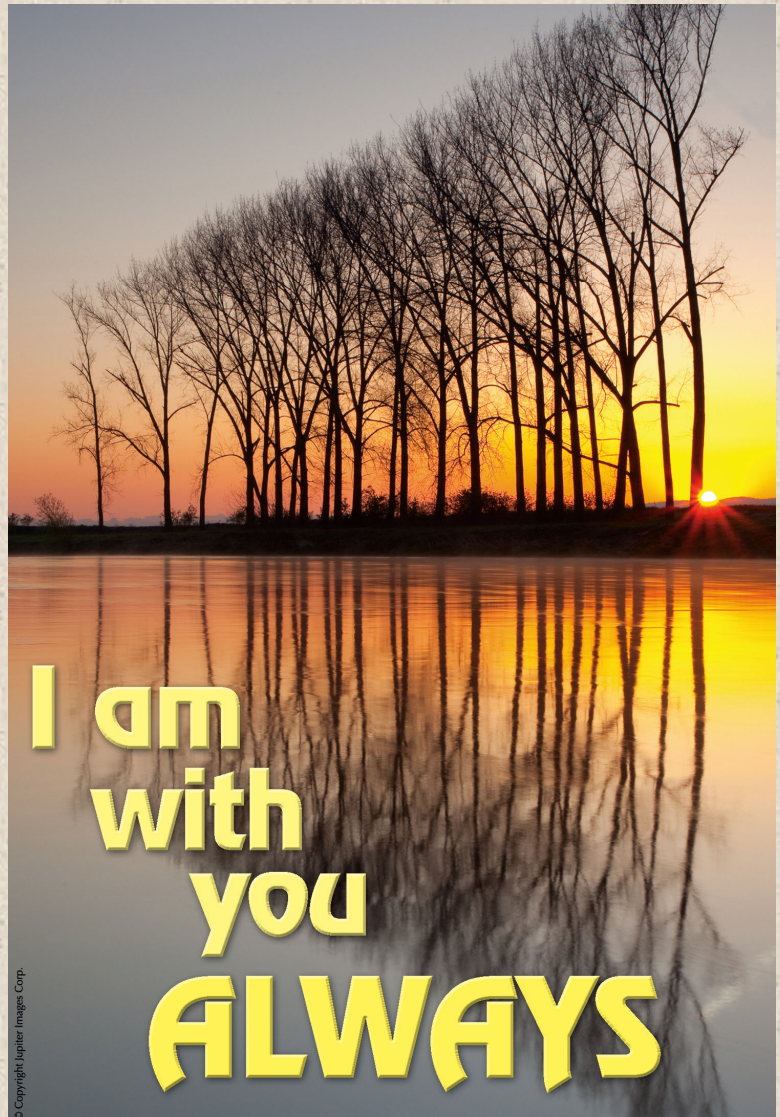

**From Deacon Don's desk:**

Fr. Leonard, SJ spoke about the new telephone technology. He reflected back to the days of the old phone system, getting a real live person picking up the phone. "One day while waiting, I wondered what would happen if God decided to install voice mail. Imagine praying and hearing this: 'Thank you for calling heaven. Please select one of the options: Press 1 for requests; Press 2 for thanksgiving; Press 3 for complaints; Press 4 for all other personal inquiries. Press 5 for whereabouts of deceased family; Press 6 for your heavenly reservation.' After 15 minutes, 'Our computers show you have already prayed three times today. Please hang up and try again tomorrow.'"

In the Acts of the Apostles (1st Reading), "The earliest church constantly devoted themselves to prayer; and John's Gospel has Jesus praying for Himself and His followers. An unexpected 'gift' of Easter is the ease with which we should be able to pray. Our God can't do more than show us how real and powerful His love is than in the life, death, and resurrection of His Son Jesus. Through Jesus we are brought into the family of God.

Jesuit priest, Frank Wallace, wrote a book on prayer called "Encounter, Not Performance." He says, "Prayer is an encounter. We do not have to do anything in prayer. God does not need a show from us, in fact the more we pretend before God, the more God must wonder why we are going through this routine."

We have to be available to God and experience His loving presence in ways that help us draw closer to the One who created, loves, sustains, and saves us. What helps one in prayer may not help another, and so the rich diversity in the church's tradition in prayer reflects the variety of ways we are able to encounter God. The best rule of thumb I know for prayer is, "If it helps, do it; if it doesn't, don't."

OUR PRAYER: Lord Jesus, let us never take it upon ourselves to judge others. Enable us to leave all judgment to You, for You are the all-knowing and all-powerful Judge. Amen

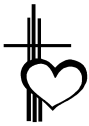
