Trinity Sunday is here.

In today's second reading, Paul calls the Corinthians to be a community united in Christ. He reminds them that the God to whom they have committed themselves is a God of love who gave us His only Son. The love and power that brings the Father and the Son together with each other is the Holy Spirit. The very Spirit of God is what brings us together as well; in the Church, in our families, and in our "Small Church Community." In the Gospel, Jesus declares that He is God's only Son, the one who has come from God. He is the means through whom salvation will be given. And this salvation that God confers is based on faith. Those who believe that Jesus is the Son of God will be saved, while others will condemn themselves by their refusal to believe.

It's great to think that God invites us to share in such a great mystery. In this shared Life and love we may think of the simple and ordinary ways we reach out to others with a smile, a helping hand or a kind word. Such love as this can only be matched by those who share in divine life. We are to be in relationship with each other.

Next week we will be offered Jesus' "real food" and "real drink" in the Eucharist to sustain those who believe. Your challenge today is to, "Recall a celebration of the Mass that meant a lot to you."

God sent His Son to save us and to forgive us, making us His adopted children. Like the Trinity of persons, may we be united in peace and love through the Spirit through whom we offer God praise and glory.

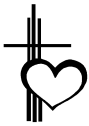
