From Deacon Don's desk:

In the first reading, Elijah is on the lamb--running for his life. Elijah hid in a cave. The Lord told him to wait and He will be passing by. God did not appear in the earthquake, the fire, or the great wind. God was in the tiny whispering sound.

When things get tough, trusting in God does not require us to seek something spectacular but the simple things in life. Slow down and reflect on the sunrises and sunsets.

One day, the father of a wealthy family took his son on a trip to the country with the objective of showing him how poor people live. They spent two days on a farm of a very poor family. On the return home, the father asked his son, "How was the trip?" "It was great Dad!" "Did you see how poor people live?" The son replied, "Oh yeah." "So tell me what you learned from the trip." The son said, "I saw that we have a dog and they have four. We have a pool that reaches to the middle of our garden and they have a creek that has no end. We have imported lanterns in our garden, they have stars at night. We have servants to serve us, but they serve others. We buy our food, they grow theirs. We have walls around our property to protect us; they have friends to protect them. Thanks Dad for showing me how poor we are."

In the Gospel Jesus sends the disciples off in the boat. On the Sea of Galilee a storm brews and the boat is tossed about. Not only are they fearful of the storm, but they see a ghost! They are really scared now! But Peter recognizes Jesus walking on the water. Peter, filled with **faith**, starts to walk on the water but his mind wanders; he is now doing something not normal and begins to sink. Jesus reaches out His hand and says, "O you of little **faith**, why do you doubt?"

We are no different than Peter; we have our ups and downs. Married life blossoms like a flower, then turns into a challenge! Why can't our spouse see things the way we do? Why can't he be perfect in every way? Too often in movies and TV we see violence, crime and infidelity. Does this cause us to lose **faith** in God? It shouldn't. He calls to us, "Come, be with Me for awhile, rest in Me." He reaches out His hand to support us. He guides us in ways beyond our understanding.

Fr. Pat Brennan (retreat master at Mater Dolorosa) once urged us men to use the following phrase when our spouse challenges us. Simply reply, "You just **may** be right!

OUR PRAYER: Lord Jesus, let us love You above all things and ever remain united with You. Help us to do always the things that are pleasing to You. Amen

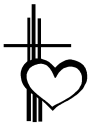
