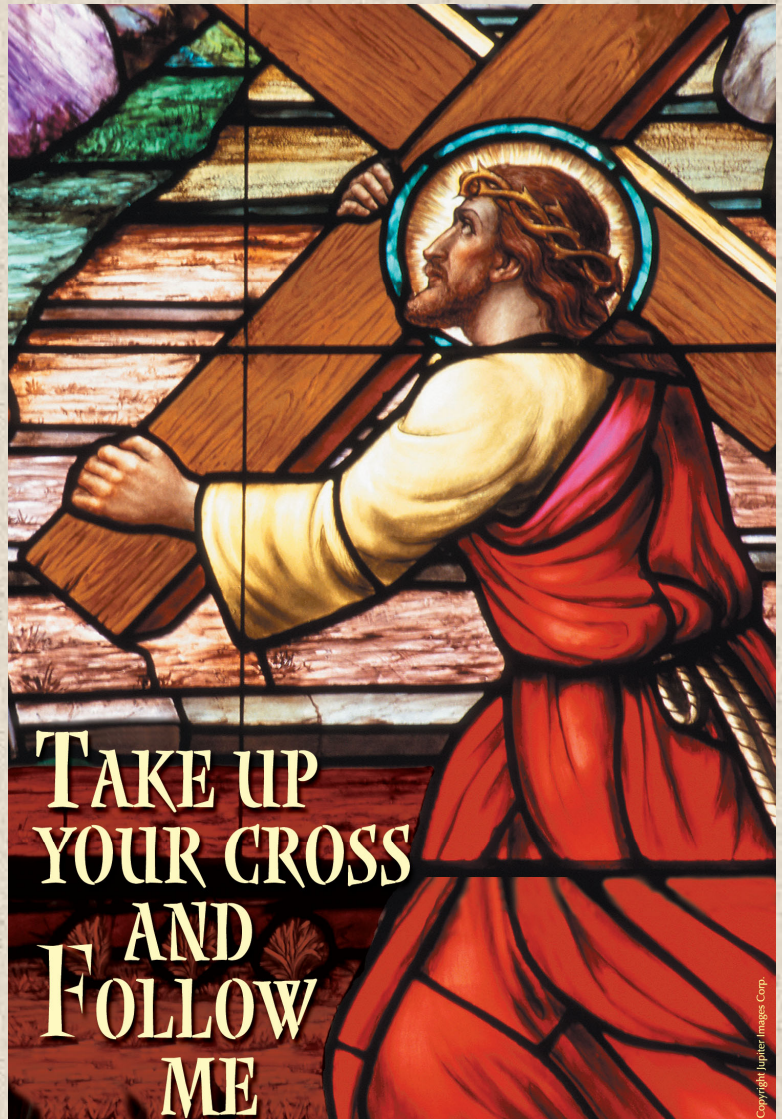

### From Deacon Don's desk:

Paul writes, "The Gospel keeps bringing blessings and is spreading throughout the world, just as it has among you ever since the day you first heard about the grace of God and came to know it as it really is." Colossians 1:6

During World War II, in anticipation of a harvest festival, a British congregation decorated its church with ripe corn ears. That night bombs destroyed the church. It lay in ruins all winter long. When spring came, shoots of corn began to sprout from the rubble. They grew tall throughout the summer. When fall came, the congregation reaped a harvest of golden corn. The Gospel is something like the seeds of that corn. Nothing can keep it from bearing fruit. The Colossians, in the above reading, are living witness to this. What is our response to the charge that the Gospel is slow in bearing fruit?

Paul again, "Keep your roots deep in Him, build your lives on Him, and become stronger in your faith as you were taught. And be filled with thanksgiving." Colossians 2:6-7

Dr. Hans Selye says one of the simplest ways to reduce stress is to develop a sense of gratitude. People who focus on life's blessings invariably experience contentment and peace while people who focus on "crosses" invariably experience anxiety and tension. Paul recommends "being filled with thanksgiving" is not only good theology but also good medicine. For what things in my life should I be "filled with thanksgiving?"

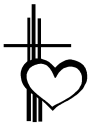
