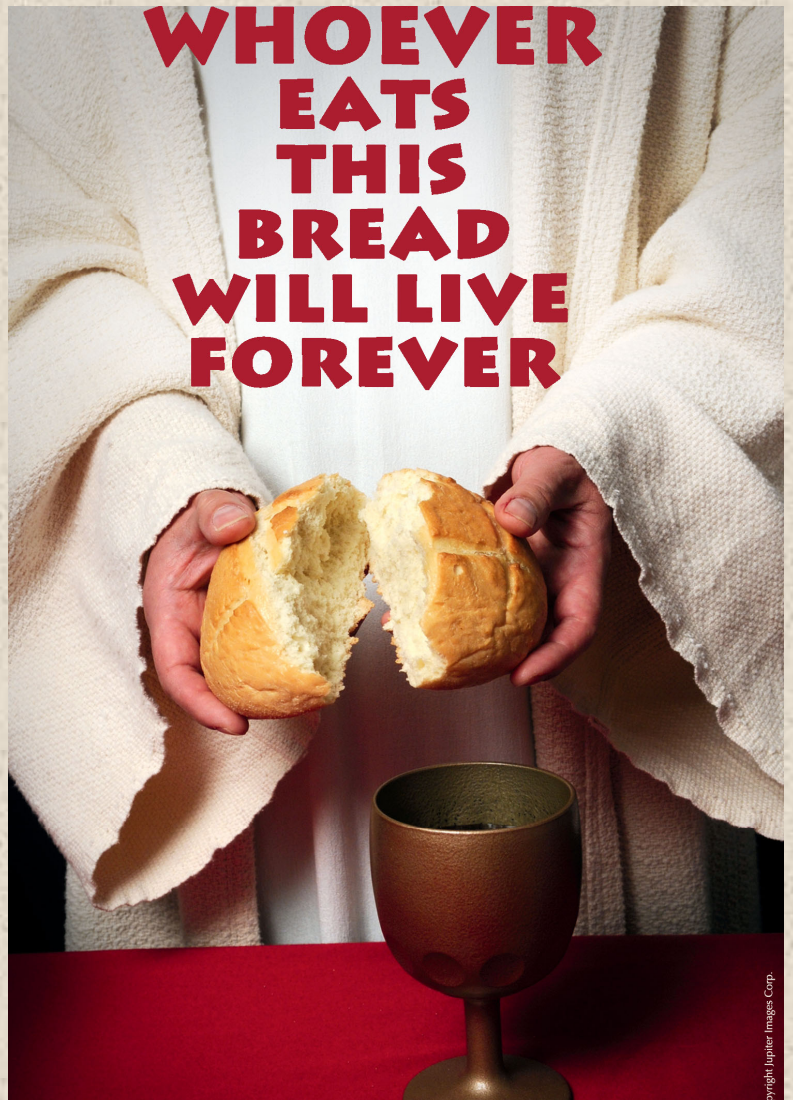

THE ARCHDIOCESE OF OWERRI IN IMO STATE OF NIGERIA. 07/18/2018

The Archdiocese of Owerri at the Eastern part of Nigeria has a population of 4.3 million people under the leadership of Archbishop Anthony J V. Obinna. The diocese was created in the year 1950 with Most Rev Joseph B. Whelan, C.S.Sp of the blessed memory as the first bishop. There was a civil war between Nigeria and Biafra in 1966-1970, and after the war the expatriate missionaries were expelled from the country by the then Nigerian government who accused the missionaries of supporting and feeding the Biafra people (IGBO PEOPLE) through Catholic Charities and Red Cross International.

The government forcefully took over the mission schools. Recently, after long persuasions, the government returned all the Catholic schools to our Archdiocese as the rightful owner and classified all the schools as private schools thereby refusing all funding from the government.

This situation has been overwhelming for our local churches. It has been very difficult for the Archdiocese of Owerri to keep all the schools and the majority of the schools are located in rural areas supporting peasant farmers and their children's education. Considering closing down those schools will be dangerous for the future of the children. Many of the schools handed back to the church are also in terrible condition and require urgent help. It has been very difficult to manage all the Catholic schools without funding from the government.

We need help towards school projects in the Archdiocese of Owerri. Thank You.

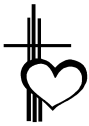
