

Be constantly vigilant anytime your children are near water...Drowning takes only a few seconds, especially when children have easy access to a body of water. #### Esther Ministry

Human trafficking is currently the second largest type of criminal activity and is exceeded only by the illegal drug trade. This crime is often linked with large sporting events, such as the Olympics, World Cup Soccer, Super Bowl, etc. It is largely hidden, which makes accurate numbers of incidents difficult to determine, but there is a demand for both commercial sex services as well as labor exploitation during these events. (Information obtained from U.S. Sisters Against Human Trafficking).
