## Welcome

Dear Parish Family:

Every month, I receive a detailed report from the Called to Renew office highlighting the pledges paid from our parishioners. Almost 500 families participated in the Called to Renew campaign and once again, thank you for your generosity. While a few of the pledges are behind in payments, the majority of you continue to be faithful and thank you for honoring your commitment to the Parish. Our parish Call to Renew funds are hard at work and let me summarize our construction project.

Our new parish pews are almost finished and will be installed upon completion of the construction project in the church. Called to Renew funds supported this project.

The asbestos/abatement project was completed last week in a couple of sections of the church including the transept, choir area and mechanical room. The AQMD did a thorough inspection and signed off with an "All Clear".

Call to renew funds are supporting our electrical service upgrade. Southern California Edison designed an electrical upgrade to meet our current and future electrical needs for our campus facilities.

The new HVAC System includes 55 tons of air conditioning to meet the needs of the church system including interior and architectural upgrades. This is being paid for by our Sunday offertory funds that accumulated in our bank account and is not being paid for by Called to Renew.

Your commitment to Call to Renew is resulting in these current works in progress. You'll witness all of the elements of our Called to Renew case statement being implemented during the next several years.

On behalf of your parish family, thank you for being faithful to your *Called to Renew Pledges*.

## Did you Know

Don't let a predator use fear to manipulate a child. Many victims of abuse don't report the abuse right away, if ever. Predators groom their victims, and part of this process is designed to make the victim feel like they should trust their predator, even more so than their own parents. Many victims also have a fear that their parents or trusted adults won't believe them, or that they will get in trouble for what happened — sometimes an abuser will threaten a child, using the child's fear to buy the child's silence. It's important for parents to teach their children to talk with their parents about what is happening to them, what might be frightening them, and that they will be supported in disclosing.
