## Welcome

Dear Parish Family:

Last week, Archbishop José Gomez announced the start of a new independent compensation program for victim/survivors of abuse in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and several dioceses in California. The ICP is entirely independent from the church. This new program is similar to programs administered in other states. Funding for the program will come from self-insurance reserves. No program funding will come from donations from the Together in mission annual appeal, Call to Renew campaign or donor designated gifts. The Archdiocese of Los Angeles continues to promote healing for victim survivors of abuse. For almost 30 years, I have served as a Knight of the Holy Sepulchre. This papal organization was established almost 1000 years ago to protect the shrines and sites where Lord Jesus Christ lived, walked, died and rose in the Holy Land. Next weekend I will be attending the annual meeting of the Western Lieutenancy of the Holy Sepulchre. Over 600 members will meet in Phoenix as we continue to pray and strategize to protect the 2% of Christians who continue to live in the Holy Land. Thank you for welcoming our visiting priests to St. Joseph's while I'm away next weekend.

May all of us continue to pray for peace in the Middle East and especially for peace in Jerusalem!

## Did you Know

The Archdiocese is participating in an independent compensation program for victim-survivors of sexual abuse of minors by priests

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles, along with five other dioceses in California, will be participating in an independent program to offer persons who were victims of abuse as minors by diocesan priests, access to compensation as well as access to counseling services if they chose. Those harmed many years ago and barred from filing lawsuits because of civil statutes of limitations will be eligible to make claims under the Independent Compensation Program for Victim-Survivors of Sexual Abuse of Minors by Priests.

The Archdiocese's participation in the program is part of a long-standing commitment to supporting and compensating victims of abuse, the protection of children and the vulnerable, and the prevention of abuse and misconduct in Catholic parishes, schools and ministries. Nationally recognized mediators and private compensation program administrators, Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros will administer the program.

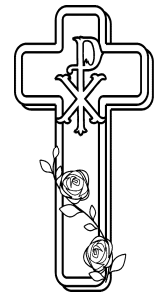

## Message from Archbishop Gomez

### **Independent Compensation Program for Victim-Survivors of Abuse by Diocesan Clergy (ICP) To Begin Sept. 16, 2019**

As part of our long-standing commitment to provide pastoral care and to support the healing process for victim-survivors, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, along with five other dioceses in California, is participating in the new

**Independent Compensation Program by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, Diocese of Fresno, Diocese of Orange, Diocese of Sacramento, Diocese of San Bernardino, and Diocese of San Diego for Victim-Survivors of Sexual Abuse of Minors by Priests (ICP).**

The ICP is administered independently of the Church by Kenneth Feinberg and Camille Biros, widely recognized as premier dispute resolution administrators in the country. The program will begin accepting registrations on Monday, September 16, 2019, from any person who has been sexually abused as a minor by diocesan priests of the participating dioceses, no matter when that abuse might have occurred. Funding for the program in our Archdiocese will come from self-insured reserves, monies set aside for this purpose. We pray that this new program might provide another avenue toward healing and hope.
