#### Did You Know...

Words can be warning signs of abuse. Many children will be learning in their own homes this fall, but that does not mean they will be fully protected from abuse. Sadly, most children are abused by someone considered to be a "known and trusted" person – that person may be a family member – even someone living in the same house as the child. Pay attention to the conversations your children are having, as words can be indicators that a child is being groomed or harmed. If your child or their friend (s) seem to "know" more about sexual topics than would be expected for their age, or seems unusually focused on such topics, it could be an indicator that something inappropriate and harmful is happening. Talk to your child about it, reassuring them that it is both important and safe to tell you what is happening. For more information on this topic.

#### ST. JOSEPH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY 2020-2021 SCHOOL STUDENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY


