




You're Called to Renew gifts are at work! As I announced a couple of weeks ago, our old baptismal font is very tired and it has not worked in almost 4 years, not only because of the pandemic, but there is a major leak in a pipe and the marble is corroded and cracked. This week we'll commence the construction of our new font which will hold the same square footage imprint as the old font. One of the new additions of the redesigned font is that it will allow for full immersion of an adult. I went with our Deacons and liturgy team to the quarry, and we chose the granite stones pictured below. The outer layer will be Lapidus Gold, and the inner layer will be Black Pearl. The General Contractors, TG Construction will commence work this week on February 8 and they plan to complete the project on March 23, two weeks before Easter!! Please walk carefully around the construction area near the back of the church and pray our design and construction teams are safe.
