





I knew Bishop David and I was honored to serve as the Master of Ceremonies at his Ordination as a Bishop in 2015. He served as the Auxiliary Bishop of the San Gabriel Region of the Archdiocese. He was a great Priest, always kind and supportive of me. He was well known for working with people on the margins of society, especially at-risk youth and gang members. As Archbishop Gomez said of him: "He was a peacemaker with a heart for the poor and the immigrant, and a passion for building a community where the sanctity and dignity of every human life was honored and protected." Bishop Dave's life was taken in the parish community of St. John Vianney, where I grew up and my vocation was fostered and nourished. He died in the home where I frequently visited my retired Pastor back in the 1990's. I will miss Dave (as I called him) very much. General Guidelines and Practices

Lenten Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of universal fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year until the beginning of their 60th year. Fasting allows for one full meal and two smaller meals not to equal one full meal. Abstinence from meat is obligatory for all who have completed their 14th year of age.

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat for all who have completed their 14th year. As always, anyone for whom fasting or abstinence would pose a health risk is excused.





Know how to report abuse in California It is important to take immediate action if someone discloses abuse to you, or if you suspect abuse or neglect is happening. The Archdiocese of Los Angeles offers a detailed list of resources with information about what to do if you suspect a child, vulnerable or elderly adult is being abused. All employees and volunteers within the Archdiocese of Los Angeles are expected to report suspected abuse to the appropriate civil authorities and to Victims Assistance Ministry. 


