



Dear Parish Family:


Welcome to the Fourth Sunday of Easter as Jesus announces that he is the Gate and the Good Shepherd. We've all been invited to follow Christ for we are the sheep and we hear the voice of the Good Shepherd.

This Sunday is called Blue Sunday. The blue ribbon has been nationally recognized as a symbol of child abuse awareness. The movement began in the Spring of 1989 when a concerned grandmother named Bonnie from Virginia, experienced the death of her grandson from abuse. She tied a blue ribbon to her van as a sign of her personal commitment to involve everyone in the battle to stop child abuse. The diligent work of the church over the last 30 years has raised awareness about the signs and symptoms of physical, emotional and sexual abuse of children. In our efforts to protect the children and the vulnerable many have completed the safeguard the children's programs and through the years we realize that we must apply the standards of safety to everyone. Virtus has taught us that there could be great denial when it comes to recognizing that family and friends that we know could abuse others. 30% of abuse is done by people who are biologically related to the child victim and an additional 60% of abuse is done by people known to the child victim but not biologically related. Thank you for all that you do as a safe adult and please scroll down to the section to read about how our local church is actively protecting children. Pray for the victims of child abuse. Pray for an end to child trafficking. Be diligent and aware as we continue to protect any child that is at risk or harm.




