

## EMoHC Guidelines

Covid restrictions are lifted. Vaccinated individuals no longer have to wear masks indoors. Some clarification regarding the distribution of Holy Communion is still needed from the Archdiocese so for now the following protocols are in place for EMOHC serving indoor and outdoor Masses at St. Joseph

- During the Lamb of God, the assigned EMOHC comes up to the altar and stands at the side. You must bring your mask with you. You don't have to wear it coming up, unless you are not vaccinated. You could also wear it if you are vaccinated. For the time being all of us will wear masks while distributing Holy Communion to the faithful.
- After the Msgr. Kevin receives Holy Communion, he will put on his mask and sanitize his hands. He or the Deacon will give you Holy Communion and you should proceed to put on your mask and sanitize your hands.
- For indoor Masses, come into the sacristy before Mass, sign in and select your Communion station. For the 8:30 Outdoor Mass, sign up in the garage, next to the field.
- Communion from the Cup is still not allowed.
- Communion in the hand is preferred, but if someone wants to receive on the tongue, that is OK and do not deny them Holy Communion.
- The blue tape is gone in the Church, so the church is fully reopened.
