Exit Interview Appointment

You can expect to receive an email regarding the exit interview. You will be invited to schedule an appointment using a link to Sign-up.com. Interviews are typically conducted between March and April. We look forward to meeting with you and your Candidate next spring!

Confirmation Interview Information

All candidates must be interviewed prior to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Confirmation exit interview is a part of the Confirmation faith formation process. It is the final -step in officially completing the two-year faith formation program requirement. This process helps us to determine your candidate's readiness to move forward in receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. This is also a time for the teen to evaluate their experience throughout the process. Our goal is to make the journey more meaningful for others in the future.

Confirmation Sessions

As a willing participant in the Confirmation process, we expect all teenagers to fully participate in the large and small group discussions. Their full participation shows us their readiness for Confirmation. Our intent is to offer a place where it is safe for them to ask questions and to share their feelings about God and about being Catholic.

Confirmation Ceremony Parent Information

Expect to receive an email that will include details about the Confirmation Ceremony. The pdf booklet will have information about the rehearsal, dress attire and more.

Guidelines

- Respect the leader and other group members.
- Bring a good attitude and a willing spirit.
- Respect the privacy of each member in your group.
- Electronics may be used during sessions only when instructed by the leaders.
- All AirPods, Earphones, EarPods, or Headphones are forbidden while classes/retreats are in session.
- No smoking, drugs, alcohol, or profanity at any Youth Ministry/Confirmation event are allowed.
- Students who have drivers' licenses are not permitted to drive other students to any Youth Ministry function off-site.
- Permission slips and behavior contracts must be signed by parent and teen before the Candidate can attend a Youth Ministry event or service project activity that is not held at St. Joseph campus.
- Keep a positive attitude towards your fellow Candidates and volunteers. Please always remain respectful to everyone.
- Retreats: Students may not bring any water bottles or refillable containers to any retreat. Water will be available to all Candidates if needed.
- Kindly, do not share your snacks with others. Keep in mind we may have students with life-threatening food allergies.

Parent Drop-Off

Please drop off and pickup your student ON TIME.

Discipline

If there is a problem in a workshop, retreat, or activity the following will happen.

- 1st Violation – Discussion with parent.
- 2nd Violation – Postpone Confirmation preparation until next year or until candidate decides they want to participate.

Probation

If a candidate were to leave an event without permission, the candidate will be placed on probation for 2 years. During the probation the parish will not take the responsibility for the candidate and a parent or guardian must accompany the candidate to any attended event.

Attitude:

Candidates are expected to voluntarily participate in the Confirmation journey and adhere to the established guidelines. Failure to do so may result in the candidate being asked to leave the session, with the session not being considered as completed. Parents will be notified promptly if such a situation arises.

Mass

Attending Mass is part of the faith formation session. **STUDENTS MAY NOT LEAVE EARLY.** We encourage the faith formation families to join their candidates for the 12:30pm Youth Mass.

Absences

Candidates are permitted 3 absences per Confirmation year. **CONSECUTIVE ABSENCES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

If more than 3 absences are missed, the year will not count towards High School Faith Formation. **Missing the 3- day away retreat counts for 3 absences.**

Late Arrival

Our sessions are held on Sundays at 11:00am in the PLC building. The doors will be closed at 11:10am, anyone who is late will not be allowed to attend the workshop for the day. Being late is not respectful to the other candidates or Catechists.

Sponsor Requirements

The sponsor for any candidate may be male or female and is to be sufficiently mature, at least 16 years of age, a fully initiated Catholic. The sponsor should be a Catholic living a life of faith that aligns with the responsibilities of being a sponsor.

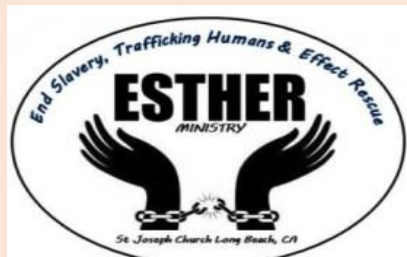

Welcome!

The two-year process for Confirmation at St. Joseph's Church is an important event for our entire Parish Community. It is when our Parish youth are committing themselves to Christ and His Church. Our young parishioners are making a purposeful decision to step forward and choose their faith just as their parents did for them at their Baptism.

The process of Confirmation presents a unique and personal challenge to become involved in the Church and continue the mission of Jesus Christ. The preparation process is a journey which will bring our youth to full membership of the Church.

At St. Joseph, Confirmation is part of Youth Ministry. The minimum amount of time to complete the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, as determined by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, is two years. Candidates for Confirmation could take as long as four years, if needed. As a gentle reminder, no candidate should feel that they are pressured or obligated to join the formation process. This would not only defeat the purposes of the program but could create an atmosphere which has the potential to affect the spiritual growth of others.

It is expected that those who wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation accept the above-stated understanding of what it means to be Confirmed. Each candidate will participate fully in the process and engage in meaningful reflection on what it means to be a member of the Church.

Failure to meet any of the expectations and/or complete any of the requirements herein stated is equivalent to withdrawal from the program for the year. Candidates may re-enroll the following year.

While the Sacrament of Confirmation is for our youth to become a part of the Church, it is also a special invitation for parents to renew and deepen their own commitment to God and His Church.

We are asking our parents, and candidates with parents' approval, to sign up to the BAND APP on your electronic devices. (QR can be found below) The Band App is designed to ease group communication and reach members easily with posts on the community board and share upcoming events without making a single phone call.
